Custom as the Regulator of Polish Social Life in Early Modern Times

It is the first attempt (published in English) in the Polish historiography to see the custom as an important factor shaping social life. The Polish state in early modern times was extremely weak and the Polish legal system inefficient. In such a situation custom was the ruler, delimiting the boundaries between social groups, imposing patterns of behaviour for members of different social strata, for males and females, for young and old, as well as posting warning signals against any trespassing.
